Minimum Education Level – High school diploma or equivalent

Minimum Experience Requirements

- Four years electronics maintenance experience in the following areas:
 - Digital/analog signal processing
 - Electromechanical devices
 - Video signal processing and recording
 - Communications (multiplexer equipment, VHF, UHF, microwave, fiber-optic)
 - Digital/analog computer systems
 - DC power supplies
 - Test equipment
 - Optical equipment
 - Familiar with O&M of portable AC generators

Minimum Position-Specific Training Required

- Formal classroom education equivalent to Navy "C" School or vocational school with formal training in the field of electronic equipment maintenance
- Physically able to assist in lifting/carrying/loading pods onto trailer pods
- Physically able to perform maintenance on TIS including loading/unloading equipment from helicopters; able to climb/descend towers and mountains carrying equipment
- IA Awareness Training
- Possess a valid state Driver's License

Description of General Duties

Applies comprehensive technical knowledge to solve complex problems by interpreting manufacturers' manuals or similar documents. Performs troubleshooting and repair of complex electronic circuits.

Performs organizational and intermediate-level maintenance on assigned equipment. Assists in depot repairs, overhaul, or rebuild of assemblies, subassemblies, and other end items, including the manufacturing of parts, modifications, testing and reclamation. Maintains AIS log books. Uses complex test equipment (spectrum analyzers, sweep oscillators, signal generators) to perform troubleshooting, isolate malfunctions and repair to the component level.

Isolates malfunctions and incorporates engineering changes. Work requires familiarity with the interrelationships of circuits and judgment in planning work sequence and in selecting tools and testing instruments. Receives technical guidance, as required, from supervisor or higher-level technician. Work is reviewed for compliance with accepted practices.

Performs troubleshooting, isolates malfunctions, repairs to the component level. Applies detailed understanding of the interrelationships of RF operating system diagnostics and circuits. Uses complex test instruments such as pulse generators, spectrum analyzers, distortion analyzers and computer analytical equipment.

Provides technical guidance to lower-level technicians and operators. Supports special tests, evaluations and equipment installation and relocation. Performs organizational, intermediate and depot-level maintenance on assigned equipment. Applies knowledge of interrelationships of circuits and judgment in planning work sequence and selects tools and testing instruments.
