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Software QA Tester & Test Engineer

Candidate will provide test software and hardware products prior to customer release and provide customer support as necessary. Candidate will be required to assist in developing test procedures and test scenarios using experience and knowledge to devise more efficient ways of testing; write and maintain Quality Assurance test plan documents; review user manuals prior to software release; assist in technical support tasks such as laboratory monitoring and configuration, demonstrations, and presentations; provide technical support for other organizational departments; and travel to support tests and training classes.

Candidate must present a professional, positive, customer service-oriented attitude. He/she must be able to read technical data, independently troubleshoot software conflicts, and recommend solutions.

Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

1. Define, write and execute test plans and procedures.
2. Create and document test procedures for new software enhancements.
3. Learn new EPG tools and develop test plans.
4. Assist with the demonstration of EPG tools.
5. Test software prior to public release.
6. Work closely with the software engineers to resolve customer problems.
7. Analyze a variety of engineering data.
8. Generate test reports and weekly reports.
9. Make recommendations to management on software test process improvement, including recommending new/updated automated test capabilities.
10. Able to explain, document and perform quality assurance tests on EPG products.

Qualifications: Candidate must be able to work overtime or weekends. Candidate must be able to travel. Candidate must have a valid driver's license with an insurable driving record.
